Non-Party Confidentiality Agreement

I acknowledge that I am not a party in the dispute between _____ and _____, which has been submitted to Wellspring for conflict coaching, mediation, and/or arbitration pursuant to the *Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation* of the Institute for Christian Conciliation ("ICC").¹ However, by agreement of the above-named parties I will be participating in all or part of the conciliation process regarding this dispute until one or both parties determine otherwise, until I determine that I can no longer participate due to biblical, or personal reasons, or until such time as the conciliators determine that my participation is no longer necessary and/or productive to the conciliation process. As a condition of my participation, I agree to protect the confidentiality of this process and will not discuss these matters with people who do not have a necessary and legitimate interest in them. Furthermore, I agree to maintain the confidentiality of all communications, written or oral, with Wellspring and the conciliators, and all communications, written or oral, between the parties during the mediation process in accordance with Rules 16 and 17 of the *Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation*.

I agree that any dispute with Wellspring or any conciliator arising from or related to this agreement shall be settled by mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration in accordance with the *Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation*¹ of the Institute for Christian Conciliation, which are incorporated by reference herein and which I agree to follow. I agree that judgment upon an arbitration decision may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction. I agree that these methods shall be my sole remedy and expressly waive my right to file a lawsuit in any civil court for any claim arising out of or in any way related to this agreement, except as necessary to enforce an arbitration decision.
